Efforts to improve healthcare access and patient health outcomes have predominantly focused on health system factors. Having access to care, including medications, is of keen interest and concern to patients, providers, and policy-makers. Increasingly, there has been recognition that improving care access and patient health will require focusing on social, economic, and environmental factors. As our health system continues to move towards value-based care, healthcare stakeholders are progressively regarding the social determinants of health (SDOH) as critical components of value. After attending the Forum, attendees will be able to:

- Discuss the impact of social determinants on health, including medication access and quality;
- Inform new opportunities for improving care by targeting patients' unmet social needs;
- Socialize a conceptual framework describing the medication access patient journey and its implications for quality measurement; and
