Presentation Formats

- **Rapid Fire/"Quality Quips":** 30-minute session on emerging trends, designed to be a highly focused, innovative, timely session to share ideas, best practices; 20 minutes + 10-minute interactive discussion. Limited to 1 or 2 speakers.
- **Proposal Learning Objectives:** It is a requirement to submit a minimum of 3 learning objectives. Please refer to <u>PQA's Guidelines for Learning Objectives</u>.
- Considerations:
 - PQA will be offering ACPE continuing education credits for most of its sessions. Please indicate whether the proposed session could be eligible/considered for CE accreditation by PQA's accrediting partner. ACPE-eligible sessions are preferred.
 - PQA will give preference to presentations that are considered 'above brand' and are non-commercial.
